New JEDS athlete Cassandra Dunser has won the girls U12 singles final at the Queensland Junior championships defeating Molly Pollack 6-2, 0-6, 6-1. Matilda Hurst was beaten in the final of the U14 division 6-0, 6-2 at the same tournament.

At the Optus 14's winter nationals unseeded pair, Wan-Yi Sweeting (WA) and Tarlina Tipungwuti (NTIS) lost the 14s girls doubles final to Sophie Letcher and Bernadette Massih 7-6; 6-2. Cassandra Dunser was a semi finalist in the 12s Singles title at the same event losing in 3 sets to the number 1 seed. Emily Webb won her first round but lost in the second round in the 12s. In the 12s Doubles Dunser with partner Kanika Vaidya from Singapore teamed up to lose to eventual winners Guan and Sanders 6-3,6-4 in the semi finals.

Coaches and PES Staff

Matt Brearley has been invited to Beijing in August with the men's and women's National hockey teams to assess the acclimatisation of both teams. He says I'll be measuring core temperature during games and examining the relationship between this data and ratings of thermal sensation, perceived exertion, muscle soreness and fluid turnover. In addition to measuring heat related variables, respiratory measures will be assessed to examine how Beijing's pollution influences the athletes' ability to respire. I'll also be monitoring air quality which could prove to be interesting as the authorities are planning to shutdown some factories in an effort to reduce pollution a couple of days after I arrive. So the testing is very comprehensive with the aim of maximising the competitive advantage of the Australian Hockey teams and all Australian athletes for Beijing 2008. The data will also contribute to the small field of knowledge regarding specific heat acclimatisation strategies and assist the NTIS to strengthen our niche as the National Heat Training and Acclimatisation Centre within the SIS/SAS and pro-team network.
